Dress Code

Coming to class properly dressed is a part of the discipline associated with taking dance class. It is extremely important for a dancer to be able to move without the distractions of baggy clothing or loose hair. Please bring all shoes in a dance bag to class with you. Do not wear dance shoes outside! Please label all shoes and bags. Failure to wear required dancewear could result in the student being asked to sit out of class.

Twirly Twos: Comfortable clothing and bare feet or ballet shoes

Combo I and II: Black or pink leotard with pink tights, pink ballet shoes, black tap shoes, hair in a ponytail, ballet skirt is optional

Combo III: Same as Combo I and II, black jazz shoes are optional, shorts can be worn for jazz portion

Mini Hip Hop: Shirts and shorts. No baggie clothing. Black jazz shoes or hip hop shoes

Ballet II – V: Hair in a secure bun with hair pins and a hairnet, black leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes. No skirts, shirts, or shorts

Jazz I – V: Leotard, tights, dance shorts or black jazz pants, jazz shoes (or Pedinis for levels IV and V) Hair in a ponytail. (Suntan pedinis will be needed for Jazz IV and Jazz V recitals)

Lyrical I-II: Leotard, tights, dance shorts, dance paws, jazz shoes, or ballet shoes (or Pedinis for level II), hair in a ponytail

Tap II –V: Attire same as Jazz, black tap shoes. Tap III and above may not wear the Junior tap shoes.

Hip Hop: Shirts and shorts or sweats. No jeans. Black dance sneakers - no regular sneakers will be allowed!

Regular sneakers and street shoes cannot be worn on dance floors!

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
